## Registration

### **Team Registration**

WTHL coordinator will manually add registered teams with corresponding team reps to the website after registration period closes (wthl.redzoneleagues.com)

#### **Player Registration**

Existing members:

- 1. Can login and request to join, team rep must accept request
- 2. Team rep can manually search for players and add them to the team

New members:

Need to sign up on the redzoneleagues website https://wthl.redzoneleagues.com/menu/player-sign-up-website

#### ALL MEMBERS (including coaches and non-playing referees)

Need to complete the waiver form **<u>before</u>** competing, if not then insurance is void in case of injury. Players found to have not signed waiver will have game(s) changed to forfeit as players are not eligible to play if the form is not complete. \*waiver available on website under "registration"

#### Rosters

Players can be added to your roster up until playoffs however playoff rosters will be determined with 4 regular season games remaining (i.e. new players will not be eligible for playoffs if added after **February 9th**, **2024**).

Please have rosters updated by October 20th so gamesheets can be printed. If you add players after sheets are printed, be sure to add them by hand until printed rosters are updated.

#### Eligibility

Regular season: All players must be signed up on a roster and complete a waiver before playing in any game

Playoffs: must play in **5 regular season games** with 2 exceptions: injury or recent pregnancy. The league should be aware of the medical exclusion *in advance*. It is not necessary to disclose any details. If the player is present and on the game sheet for the requisite number of games, then the disclosure is not necessary.

#### League fees

#### \$1,800 per team due before October 20th

Includes gym time, referees, new team ball, and insurance. Please Etransfer entire amount to Rena at <u>MTHFtreasurer85@gmail.com</u> o Team name in memo and the password should be "handball"

Please contact me privately if you wish to pay by cheque

CTHF fees: Nothing to talk about at the moment, will inform if there is any new information.

#### Performance Bonds

\$150 performance bond should be paid separate from league fees and before the season starts. Teams may roll their bond over from the previous season.

Deductions for following infractions:

- 1. \$100 Default with <48 hrs notice (\$50 to League and to opposing team)
- 2. \$50 Missed scorekeeping assignment (\$50 to whoever covers)
- 3. \$50 Missing mandatory meeting (\$50 to the League)

If bond dips below \$100, you will need to top up before you can play again.

### Gamesheets

- At the end of each day, the last person to scorekeep will take pictures of the entire day's games and email/text them to Danielle or Josh
- Ensure date and time is visible
- Ensure FULL GAMESHEET is visible

### Schedule

#### Defaults

3 strike policy: on a team's 3rd forfeit, they will be suspended from the league for the remainder of the season including playoffs. Players on this team will not be permitted to transfer to other teams.

>48 hrs notice = 10-0 loss with no penalty, no longer rescheduling games<48 hrs notice = 10-0 loss with \$100 deduction from performance bond</p>i.e. immediate need to replenish bond

### Scorekeeping expectations

- A. Each team is obligated to provide a scorekeeper and timekeeper for each game
- B. Arrive minimum of 10 minutes before scheduled game
- C. Sign the game sheet, names and team name
- D. Get each team to amend roster before start of game (if needed)
- E. Stay off cell phones
- F. Cross off missing players from each team at halftime
- G. First game of the day: Grab score clock and gamesheets
- H. Last game of the day: Put away score clock and send pictures to admin

#### Playoff format

- Will continue to do full bracket with consolation side
- Single games, no longer best of 3
- 25 minute halves with tie-breaker rules

### Standings

Regular Season:

- 2 points for win, 1 point for tie, 0 points for loss
- Final standings will be determined in the following order
  - 1. Points
  - 2. Head to head
  - 3. Goals against
  - 4. Results vs. common opponents
- Playoff tie-breaker format
  - 1. 1st OT (2 x 5 minute halves)
  - 2. 2nd OT (as 1st)
  - 3. 5 person shoot-out (5 different players, alternating team shots)
    - a. coin toss to determine who shoots first
  - 4. 1-1 sudden death

### Insurance

- Please contact WTHL should any injury occur while playing during one of our league games
- Will need to be filled out both by injured player and WTHL Coordinator to submit to Insurance Company
- Limited Coverage
